

Report on Pratibha: Centre for Foundation Classes, 2020-2021

Janki Devi Memorial College (JDMC), University of Delhi, under Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has successfully completed the fourth batch of Pratibha: Centre for foundation classes (competitive exams) under the convenorship of Md. Zubeer Ahmed and five coconveners; Ms Khachungla Challang, Ms. Debahuti Brahmachari, Mr Ahirrao Dinesh Bharat, Raju Keshari and Pavan Kumar. Those students who aim to clear the various competitive exams conducted by UPSC, State Public Service Commissions, Universities etc. opted for these classes. The primary objective of these foundation classes was to provide the basic knowledge about important topics from examination point of view, and orient the students to explore further on their own. The topics for lectures were selected keeping in mind the general studies component of various competitive exams.

The classes were open for all bonafide students and ex-students of the University of Delhi. The classes began in September 2020, whereby 34 students registered for the classes. The course was divided into 81 modules covering the broad areas of History, Economics, Political Science, Sociology, English, Mathematics, Geography, Science & Technology, Current Affairs, Essay writing and components of Personality test. The classes were taken by the successful candidates in the Civil Services exam, faculties from various departments of the college and experts from outside. Three modules of two hours each were discussed on every Sunday. Owing to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic, the lectures were delivered in online mode through Google Meet platform. Five mock tests and five mock tests discussions were held to assess students learning and performance, and to provide tips to solve the questions.
