







Gender Sensitisation Workshops

WDC and The Centre for Gender Equity Studies organised a series of Gender Sensitisation Workshops in September 2023, the first of which was held on 13 September 2023. The Workshop was conducted by Ms. Shubhika, the Founder and CEO of FIFE, an organisation working to eliminate gender based discrimination and violence.

In the first Workshop, Ms. Shubhika, introduced the students to the concept of gender and the need for sensitisation of gender related issues within society. Ms. Shubhika conducted multiple activities for the students which helped them to understand the concepts introduced by her. The first Workshop witnessed enthusiastic participation from the students and was highly beneficial for them.


