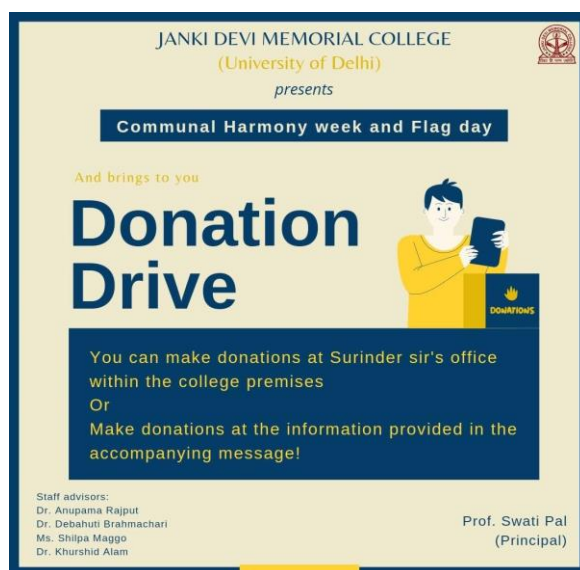
Celebration of Communal Harmony Week and Flag Day

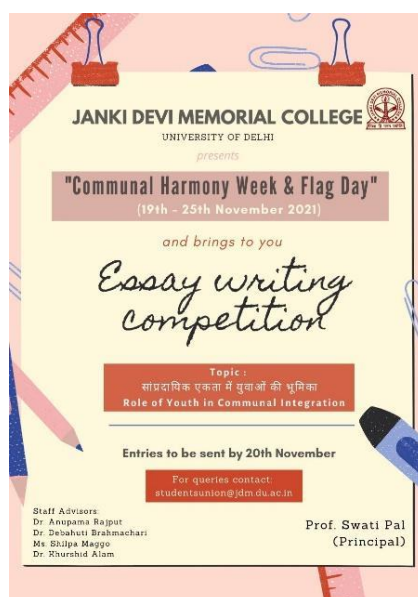
Janki Devi Memorial College, in collaboration with the National Foundation for Communal Harmony(NFCH), organised an activity-based campaign from 19th **November to 25th November 2021**, on the observance of **Communal Harmony Week and Flag Day 2021**. The campaign focused at spreading awareness about the need for fostering communal harmony, national integration and fraternity. The campaign also held a donation drive throughout the observance of this week. The amount collected had been donated to the National Foundation for Communal Harmony which aims to provide financial assistance to children rendered orphan or destitute in communal caste, ethnic or terrorist violence for their education and rehabilitation under the project 'Assist'.



The week commenced with an **Essay Writing Competition**, which presented the students with the opportunity of presenting their thoughts on the current scenario of the nation's communal harmony and the need of national integration, that has been cooking up in their minds and providing their point of view to the kaleidoscopic mass.

The competition took place on 19th and 20th November, 2021. The topic for the same was 'Role of Youth in Communal Integration.' The competition was judged by Ms. Tannu Sharma (Department of English) and Dr. Sangeeta Gupta (Department of Hindi). The 3 winners Rudrani Borthakur (1st Prize), Himani Godara (2nd Prize) and Ritika Singla (3rd Prize) were

awarded with cash prizes Rs. 500, Rs. 300 and Rs. 200 respectively. The winning entries were sent to the Ministry of National Foundation For Communal Harmony and were awarded appreciation certificates from the same.



Further on into the week, a **Poster Making Competition** was held 21st of November, 2021. Tapping into their creative side and presenting us with their magical art, the participants took this opportunity to showcase their skills, passion and ideas on communal harmony and national integration through the colourful world of posters.

The topic for the competition revolved around communal harmony, national integration and fraternity. This competition was judged by Kalakriti Society- The Art Club of Janki Devi Memorial College. The 3 winners announced were Archna Kumari (1st Prize-Rs. 500 Cash Prize), Lipsa Patra (2nd Prize- Rs. 300 Cash Prize ) and Mahak Swarnkar (3rd Prize- Rs. 200 Cash Prize). The winning entries were sent to the Ministry of National Foundation For Communal Harmony and were awarded appreciation certificates from the same.

Under the guidance of Prof. Swati Pal (Principal of JDMC) and Dr. Debahuti Brahmachari (CTO NCC), organised an **Online Declamation Competition** on 22nd November, 2021 for NCC cadets.
